



STUDENT UNIFORM POLICY AND PROTOCOLS

The College uniform is designed to assist all students and families to ensure balance and encourage self-discipline and self-regulation. It is designed to ensure student safety across the campus and enforces sun safety protocols that encourage a lifelong commitment to personal health and safety.

The College uniform is not available in retail stores. It is only available for purchase at the College Uniform Shop.

As such the following policies and protocols will be enforced as part of the agreed enrolment contract:

- 1. The correct uniform is to be worn at the College, travelling between home and the College and other occasions as required**
- 2. When wearing the uniform in public it is to be worn in full and as expected under normal school practice**
- 3. The College hat is to be worn at all times when students are outside**
- 4. All items of uniform should be clearly and permanently marked**
- 5. College shoes are to be kept clean and polished**

Early and Junior Years Girls - The College formal uniform consists of:

- Tartan dress
- White socks with College coloured stripes
- Black, leather, lace up shoes (not joggers)
- Embroidered College bucket hat

In colder weather, girls may wear a College fleecy jumper and navy, opaque tights.

Track pants are not to be worn with the College formal uniform.

The sports uniform consists of:

- College polo shirt
- Navy sport skorts
- White socks with College coloured stripes
- Sport sneakers
- Embroidered College cap

In colder weather, girls may wear College track pants and jacket

Early and Junior Years Boys - The College formal uniform consists of:

- Tartan collared shirt
- Formal grey shorts
- Formal grey socks with College coloured stripes
- Black, leather, lace up shoes (not joggers)
- Embroidered College bucket hat
- Tie in Terms 3 & 4

In colder weather, boys may wear a College jumper and/or long trousers.

Track pants are not to be worn with the College formal uniform.

The sports uniform consists of:

- College polo shirt
- Navy sport shorts
- White socks with College coloured stripes
- Sport shoes
- Embroidered College cap

In colder weather, boys may wear College track pants and jacket.

JEWELLERY

Jewellery is not permitted while students are in College uniform, with the exception of a watch.

Girls may also wear very plain, small studs, one in each lower ear lobe.

Boys are not permitted to wear earrings or studs.

HAIR

Extreme haircuts, hairstyles and /or colour are not consistent with the College uniform standards.

Hair is to be neat and clean upon arrival each morning.

Boys:

- Very short (gauge 2) or long hair below the collar or 'swept' across the eyes, are not acceptable styles for boys.
- Hair styles that are ostentatious, or draw undue attention to a student, are not acceptable. As example mohawks, fauxhawks, undercuts, tracks, patterns or other shaved hair 'artistry' are not acceptable.

Girls

- Long hair (below shoulder length) must be tied back and off the collar at all times.
- Hair accessories are limited to ribbons, head bands and small, plain hair bands or clips and must be either teal, gold, maroon or white.

If students or parents are unsure of acceptable standards, please discuss this matter with College leadership staff prior to decisions being made.

COSMETICS

Make-up, nail polish, or any temporary/permanent decorations on the skin are unacceptable for students in uniform.
